

VISITING MISSION GROUPS AND REPORT OF ACTIVITIES IN JMA CLINIC, June 12-19, 2009

From June 12-19, we received the visit of the Wayne County, Tennessee, brigade. Twenty-one (21) members of Churches of Christ of that area came to give their time and effort to help the needy in Honduras. A part of that group worked directly with the JMA Clinic by assisting with an eye clinic, and 306 patients were checked and provided eyeglasses.



The patients waited in line every morning from 5:00 a.m, eager to be seen. The group worked every day for almost 9 hours trying to get everybody checked.

Patients were provided, besides their eyeglasses, sandwiches and refreshments. The children were also given toys, gifts and some clothes, which they were grateful for.



The rest of the group was in charge of building a house and packing food bags for 400 families. These families included families from La Vega Church of Christ, surrounding communities, and Baxter students' families.

The group contributed with gifts to our daycare children, toys, candies, 11 boxes of crayons, and 37 toothbrushes.



They provided our pharmacy with:

- ✚ 150 tablets of multivitamins.
- ✚ 7,000 tablets of acetaminophen 500mg
- ✚ 15 tubes of ophthalmic Erythromycin 0.5% ointment.
- ✚ 24 tubes of neomycin+polymixin+dexamethasone ophthalmic ointment.

The patients at the clinic as well as the staff are very grateful for the help received, and will be praying for God's blessings over your lives for all the amazing things you do to help our people.
